Application

This is an application for judicial review in respect of Canada Revenue Agency.

Base on CRA second review for Canada Recovery Carregiving application (CRCB) dated **April 19; 2024 Ref# C0065677771-001-45**, or second review for Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB) Application, or 2nd review for Canada Emergency response benefit Application, dated **April 19, 2024; Reference# C0065677771-001-45**; and decided: **Plaintiff is not eligible** because there is not child caring.

The APLICANT makes application for:

- 1- A declaration that the decision was unreasonable, or unreasonable and unlawful, or unfair base on CRA's agent instructions (first communication with CRA about COVID-19 benefits Application, she told me to use the options #1, #1, #3, copy of note is in attached, exhibit #1) and changing that instructions in automatic machine, with unclear voice, spaceman voice, not understanding options, and fast talking in machine. At that time I taught could happen this, but I taught again, who is bagging so much to stay at home, can understand I didn't get twice and honesty too.
- 2- A declaration that because of last declaration , the applicant used the option which was instructed by CRA's agent while that option it wasn't any more CRB or CERB, specially while I had COVID-19 3-4 times and each time 3-4 months in the bed.
- 3-A declaration that applicant at any time doesn't applied in parallel for two or more payments for abusing the system, (exhibit#3)
- 4-A declaration that Respondent, it is more that 2 years which deducting money from my accounts and abusing honest Citizens by using the gift power to CRA by Ministry of Justice or Canadian Government, and as you see in CRA's statement dated June 13-2023, while we were talking about the case since 2 years ago, they took monies from my accounts with no any logic- reasonable, mathematical explanation, looks like people don't have right to know what and why they are doing, and effecting on applicant by creating psychological, economical, social life problems. In all this periods I spoke to at least 20 CRA's agents and managers, with spending lots of money to send copies of my documents..., but at the end I found out some of documents are avoid to view, or lost or throw out in garbage bin! Thanks to this National Capital Federal Tribunal ...
- 5- Costs (4 times); and...
- 6- A such other and further relief as this Honourable Court may deem just.
