This is an application for judicial review in respect of the decision of the Canada Revenue Agency (S. Constantin – Manager - Canada Emergency Benefits Validation), dated September 15, 2023, wherein they denied the applicant’s second review of the Canada Recovery Benefit application.

The applicant makes application for: An order quashing the decision of the Canada Revenue Agency wherein they determined that the applicant did not meet the criteria in support of the Canada Recovery Benefit’s eligibility criteria. And an order remitting the matter back for reconsideration.

The grounds for the application are:
Common Law - breach of fundamental justice. And excess of jurisdiction in that CRA limited grant of assistance to those with Minimum net income.


