2 This is an application for judicial review in respect of Federal Public Sector Labour
3 Relations and Employment Board decision FPSLREB # 561-02-47362 - Joshaua
4 Beaulieu & Public Service Alliance of Canada (Union of Veterans' Affairs Employees) -
5 2023 FPSLREB 100 rendered November 2, 2023. The decision was made to dismiss
6 my application without allowing it to proceed on the merits of the case.

7 The applicant makes application for: A writ of certiorari quashing the decision under
8 appeal, a writ of mandamus compelling the FPSLREB to grant an extension of the
9 timeline to allow a disabled party to make a complaint and ordering the FPSLREB to
10 allow my case to proceed on the merits of the case as has been done previously, a writ
11 of prohibition preventing the FPSLREB from dismissing the cases of applicants whose
12 applications are outside of the window to apply because of interference of their
13 disabilities.

14 The grounds for the application are Principle, Service to Justice, Errors of Fact and
15 Reason by the Adjudicator.


